Art Activity

Materials:

- pre-cut mommy, daddy, and baby ducks (page #180)
- glue
- feathers
- crayons
- · paint and brushes or sponges
- egg shells

Prop Box


three ducks in different sizes large egg for baby duck plastic hammer

Procedure:

- 1. Adult cuts out ducks.
- 2. Child glues three ducks onto a large piece of paper.
- 3. Child colors and/or paints the three ducks. (Daddy duck is black.)
- 4. Child glues feathers on ducks.
- 5. Child glues pieces of egg shells around baby duck. (Ducks may also be stapled to wooden sticks and used as hand puppets.)

Additional Activities for Final /k/

- 1. Find the Egg Find plastic eggs that are hidden around the room. Small items may be hidden in eggs for child to shake and guess "What's in the egg?" (look, shake).
- 2. Make Egg Salad Spread on cracker/bread (cook, crack/break egg, make, yolk). Save egg shells for art activity.
- 3. Take a Hike Pack a snack in a sack and go for a hike.
- 4. *Pick a Sock* Place socks into a sack and take turns picking a sock from the bag/sack. "Whose sock is this?" (sock, sack/bag, pick, pink, black, peek).
- 5. Duck, Duck, Goose Play this game in a small group.
